

# **FEERING PARISH COUNCIL**

## **BYELAW**

**BYELAW** made by the Parish Council of Feering under sections 12 and 15 of the Open Spaces Act 1906 and all other powers them enabling with respect to the open space known as Feering Playing Field, Rye Mill Lane, Feering.

### **Extent**

1. (1) This byelaw applies to Feering Playing Field, Rye Mill Lane, Feering, hereafter referred to as 'the ground'.
- (2) This byelaw does not apply to any roads within the ground for the time being designated under section 27 of the Road Traffic Act 1988.
- (3) This byelaw does not apply in respect of any dogs to which section 1 of the Dangerous Dogs Act 1991 applies.
- (4) Notice of the effect of this byelaw shall be given by signs placed in conspicuous positions in or near the ground.

### **Interpretation**

2. (1) In this byelaw 'the Council' means Feering Parish Council.
- (2) For the purpose of this byelaw the keeper of the dog shall be deemed in charge thereof, unless the dog had been placed in or taken into the charge of some other person at the time when an offence under this byelaw had been committed.
- (3) In paragraph (2) above, 'the keeper' shall include the owner of the dog or any person who habitually has it in his possession.

### **Dogs on Leads**

3. No person in charge of a dog shall, without reasonable excuse, permit the dog to enter or remain in the ground unless the dog is held on a lead and is restrained from behaviour giving reasonable grounds for annoyance.

### **Removal of offenders**

4. Any person offending against byelaw 3 may be removed from the ground by an officer of the Council or any constable.
