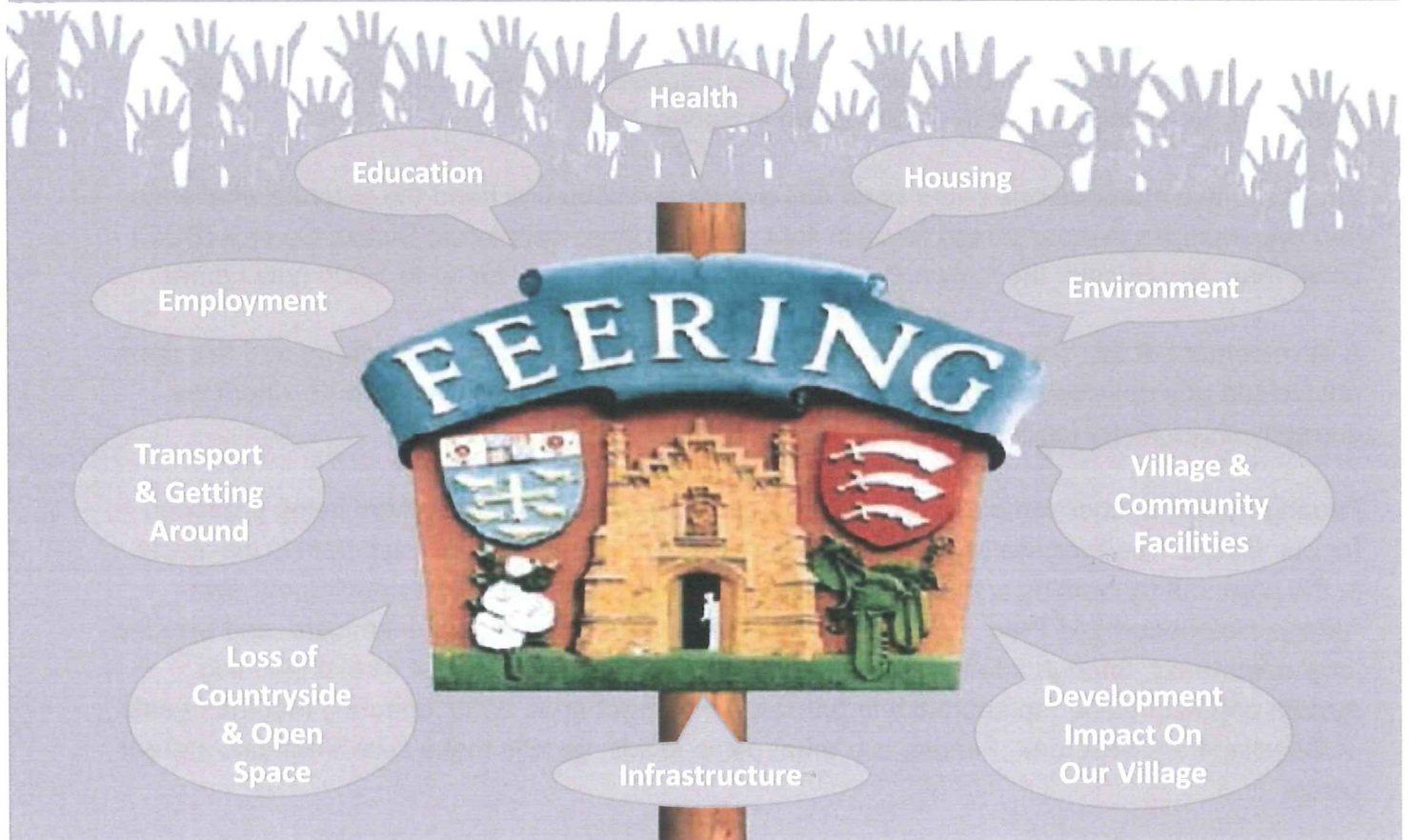

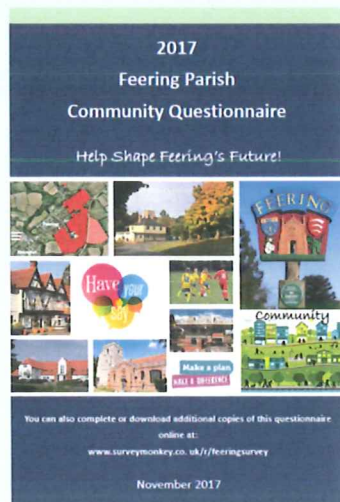

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Dear Feering Residents and Businesses,

Feering – Village Neighbourhood Plan

Firstly, may we take this opportunity to wish you and your families a Happy New Year.

Since our last update, Braintree District Council have submitted their proposed district wide local plan to the planning Inspectorate for consideration. The next step requires the planning inspector to hold an independent public examination of the proposal and whilst timings are yet to be confirmed, we anticipate that this will happen in Spring 2018.

You may have attended one of our open day events and seen first hand the potential challenges and opportunities that our village faces in light of the proposed Braintree District Council (BDC) Local Plan. In particular the Crown Estate's proposals for Feering for up to 1,000 new homes.

A development of this scale would more than double the size of our current village and this does not include any development proposals under consideration within Kelvedon, with whom we currently share many facilities.

Feering Parish Council remains strongly opposed to the scale of development being proposed for our village. However, we know that due to National policies some development is inevitable in the area, but by working with the community we are in the process of producing our own 'Village Neighbourhood Plan'. The plan, if approved by the independent examiners, and also the local community, through a referendum, will carry legal weight in the local district planning system and help guide the approach to future development up to 2033, ensuring that the needs of the village are best met - Feering is a great place to live, so let's make sure it remains a great place!

To support this plan and the policies within it, we want to ensure that we have engaged and sought the views of the whole community. You will have recently received your 'Community Survey' which many of you have completed - Thank you.
