**040/2020 CONSIDERATION OF THE FOLLOWING APPLICATIONS**

**i Marks Tey Neighbourhood Plan**

After discussion it was agreed that the clerk would prepare a submission based on the emails received from Cllr Dobson and Cllr Evans and circulate for submission before 31 May.

**ii 20/00105/TPOCON – Trebah, Worlds End Lane**

Notice of intent to carry out works to trees in a conservation Area – T1-6 Willows – Reduce crown by up to 25% (ie up to a maximum of 2.5m), G1 Group of Willow on river bank – coppice due to failure of stems, G2 Conifers dead and dying section fell to ground level

After discussion it was **agreed** that following consultation with our tree warden, we had no objection to make but would like to see that the felled tree is replaced.

**iii 20/00106/TPOCON – Northwood House, Worlds End Lane, Feering**

Notice of intent to carry out works to trees in a Conservation Area – T1 Poplar – Reduce Crown by up to 50% below previous decayed reduction points (ie no more than maximum of 10m)  
T2 3 & 4 Poplar – Reduce crowns to previous reduction points (ie no more than maximum of 4m) – General tree maintenance to safeguard future life of trees / Health & Safety

After discussion it was **agreed** that following consultation with our tree warden, we had no objection to make.
